HOUSING STOCK AND TENURE

There are **31,097** dwellings within Central Harrogate. **27.5%** of properties are flats, with houses making up **72.5%** of housing stock. **71%** of households own their own homes while **19.9%** live in privately rented accommodation.

In the last five years there have been **889** new homes built across Central Harrogate, an average of **178** per year.

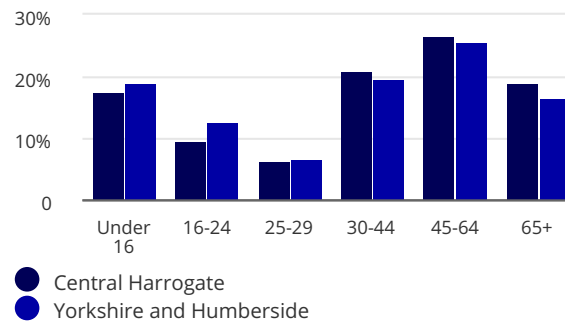
POPULATION PROFILE

There are **67,674** people living within Central Harrogate. The overall population increased by **5.2%** in the ten years between 2001 and 2011.

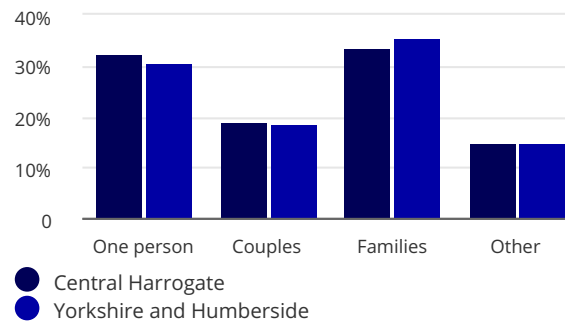
Age profile
